What has the past year taught you about resilience? In what ways were you tested? What challenges did you personally face? What did 2020 teach you about yourself, your family, your community, or your country? And how did you overcome the challenges presented by 2020 to still pursue your dreams?

Further Application Requirements

- 2021 Scholarship Essay no more than two (2) pages, typed and double-spaced
- Two (2) Letters of Recommendation teacher, counselor, principal, coach, or individual familiar with your personal achievements
- Official High School Transcript, including grades from Fall Semester 2020
- Verification of a minimum of twenty (20) completed community service hours

Applicant Profile

- Applicants must be of African or African-American descent
- Applicants must reside in San Mateo County, Santa Clara County, Alameda County, San Francisco City/County or Contra Costa County
- Applicants may be female, male, or non-binary
- Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale
- Applicant must be a high school senior, graduating in Spring 2021
- Applicant must be accepted to a two-year, four-year, or vocational college and show proof of enrollment before scholarship funds will be dispersed.
